In mid-September, the LLF hosted the 2022 Sandra Davison Memorial Golf Classic, our major fundraising event. Due to continued support from sponsors, silent auction donors, golfers and volunteers, we raised \$50,000! Thanks to all for a great day on the course.

From the groundwork, laid in 2021, the “Books are Back!” Phase II Project has provided in-class book sets to every Grade 1-3 classroom in the Limestone Board. A total of 277 sets! They include collections in English and in French and thematically represent the voices of Indigenous, 2SLGBTQ+, Black, and Authors of Colour. The titles are not curriculum-based. A special thanks to our partner Johnson Insurance for their \$30,000 donation and to the LDSB Literacy Team for curating the list.

During the pandemic years, the LLF board made a decision to favour large-scale initiatives in order to reach a broader student population. While feedback from these initiatives has been especially positive, the Foundation may move back to some level of specific project funding in the future. Currently, the LLF is working on a third iteration of the Project and Guest Speakers related to “Books are Back!” for the 2023-24 school year.
